Terence-

As a follow-up to my voicemail I left you yesterday , the repair to the elbow began today. They got 3 layers of the composite on today and have 5-6 more to go. They ran out of materials and had to overnight some more in from the east coast. The vendor will commence the repair tomorrow at approximately 11:00 AM. Once started, it will probably take several more hours to finish the repair.

From your previous site visit I recall that you wanted to be present to witness the repair. I just wanted to give you another opportunity to come out and take a look. We expect to complete the repair tomorrow - sometime in the PM.

FYI this site was secured and left open over the Christmas -New year holidays - there was no need to expand the size of the excavation to do the repair.
