At 00:50 on 1/8/11, PG&E was notified by the Fire Department of a structure fire at [Redacted].
[Redacted] The resident at this home had cleaned out a fire place and placed ashes in a container near the garage and gas meter. The ashes started a fire in the container that spread to the garage and gas meter. As a result, part of the home was damaged and the gas meterset had melted releasing natural gas.

The GSR was dispatched at 01:12 and arrived on-site at 1:43. The Fire Department had been able to shut off the gas. A crew was dispatched to squeeze off the service.

The incident was deemed to be reportable at 03:08 due to damage to the home exceeding \$50,000. There were no injuries, no fatalities, and no media as a result of this incident. The DOT was notified at 03:36 and the CPUC was notified at 03:41.
