This letter grants Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) February 4, 2011 request to extend the completion date of the initial audit of various Core Transport Agent related documents ordered in Resolution G-3440. Accordingly, the due date to complete the initial audit is no later than June 2, 2011. The accompanying audit report is to be submitted to the Director of the Energy Division no later than July 1, 2011.

In support of its request, PG&E explained that it must contend with recent demands placed on its gas department and the lack of established auditing procedures for the initial audit. We find these reasons plausible and justify extending the deadline.

PG&E shall inform all parties to PG&E Advice Letter 3033-G of this action as soon as it is practical.
