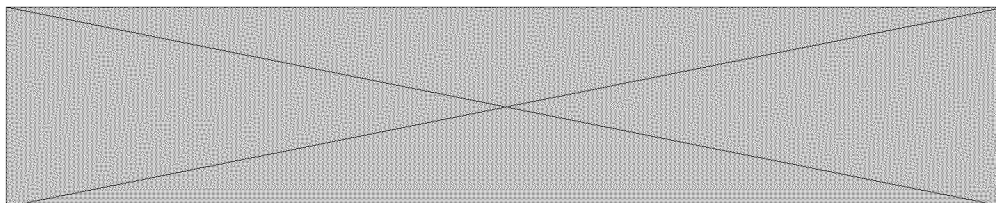

We're holding a joint conference with the Department of Energy titled "High Penetration Solar Forum" on 3/1-3/2 in San Diego. The purpose is to allow researchers to present preliminary findings to CAISO schedulers, grid engineers, utility execs, etc. Nine different research projects will be presented, with Q&A to follow.

Over the past year we've been collaborating with the DOE's Solar Energy Technologies Program. Like the CSI's RD&D Program, the DOE has grid integration of solar energy as a target area. Of the nine projects featured at this forum, three are DOE funded, three are CPUC funded, and three are jointly funded.
