REQUEST FOR ADDITION OR CHANGE TO SERVICE LIST

The CPUC maintains an official service list for all open, formal proceedings, (Official service lists may be found at http://www.cpuc.ca.gov/published/service_lists/sl_index.htm.) For purposes of Rule 1.9 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure, service of documents must be made on all persons named in the "Parties" and ""State Service" categories of the official service list. Persons named in the "Information Only" category of the official service list generally receive CPUC documents only, unless the Administrative Law Judge directs otherwise.

PARTY STATUS

Persons who become parties by filing a formal pleading, being named as a defendant or a respondent, or by the grant of a filed motion to become a party (see Rule 1.4), are routinely added to the "**Parties**" category of the official service list. The official service list will name the party by its legal name and or by the name of the primary signer representing the party, as indicated in the formal pleading.

If you are not already a party, you may request party status at a prehearing conference or hearing by providing the completed form to the Administrative Law Judge.

If you are already a party, you may use this form to substitute the named representative on the official service list. Provide the completed form to the Administrative Law Judge at hearing, or to the Commission's Process Office (505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94102 or e-mail: Process Office@cpuc.ca.gov).

STATE SERVICE (NON-PARTY STATUS)

Members and employees of the CPUC, State Legislature or other State office or agency may request to be added to the "**State Service**" category of the official service list, to receive all documents that are served pursuant to Rule 1.9. Persons included in the "**State Service**" category may not file pleadings, and they are not parties to the proceeding.

INFORMATION ONLY (NON-PARTY STATUS)

Non-parties, and additional representatives of a party, may request to be added to the "Information Only" category of the official service list, to receive electronic service of all documents in a proceeding pursuant to Rule 1.10; however, persons included in the "Information Only" category may request the Administrative Law Judge to require other additional service as appropriate. Persons included in the "Information Only" category are not parties to the proceeding.
