RE: Submittal of Reply to Protests of Advice Letter 3809-E


Dear Mr. Mathal-Jackson:

Pacific Gas and Electric's (PG&E) letter on March 22, 2011 requests a 7-day extension to file a reply to protests and responses to advice letter 3809-E, which PG&E filed pursuant to Decision 10-12-048, the decision adopting the Renewable Auction Mechanism. The letter states that PG&E supports Southern California Edison's (SCE) extension request for advice letter 2557-E, which SCE filed pursuant to the same decision. PG&E supports SCE's statement regarding the complexity of the issues surrounding RAM implementation and further notes that the advice letters should be resolved on the same schedule.

An extension is reasonable and granted. Since a 7-day extension request would require the reply to be filed on March 31, 2011, a state holiday, a 6-day extension is granted. Accordingly, the deadline for filing a reply to the protests is hereby extended from 5 business days to 9 business days, or from March 24, 2011 to March 30, 2011.

Per Rule 16.6 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure, PG&E is requested to promptly inform all parties to the proceeding of the extension and state in the opening paragraph that the Executive Director has authorized the extension.
