STIPULATION RE ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") stipulates as follows with respect to the Order to Show Cause ("OSC") issued by the Commission on March 24, 2011:

- 1. In order to protect public safety and expedite PG&E's compliance with the National Transportation Safety Board's urgent safety recommendations as required by Commission Resolution L-410, PG&E and Commission Staff developed a Compliance Plan appended hereto as Attachment A. The Compliance Plan, among other things, establishes milestones for completion of certain activities. This stipulation is presented as a resolution of the OSC and does not constitute an admission by PG&E of any fact alleged in the OSC or of any non-compliance or other violation of any order, rule, regulation or law..
 - 2. PG&E shall carry out the Compliance Plan.
 - 3. PG&E agrees to pay a penalty of \$6 million, as follows:
- a) \$3 million will be paid to the State General Fund within ten (10) days of the Commission's approval of this stipulation without modification.
- b) Payment of the remaining \$3 million will be suspended pending PG&E's completion of the Compliance Plan. Upon any unexcused failure of PG&E to meet a milestone set forth in the Compliance Plan, PG&E will pay such portion of the remaining \$3 million as the Commission may find to be appropriate to the State General Fund within ten (10) days of the Commission decision finding such unexcused failure. If PG&E successfully completes the Compliance Plan, the remaining \$3 million shall be forgiven.

- c) The penalty specified above does not limit the Commission's authority to impose additional penalties for any non-compliance by PG&E not related to completion the Compliance Plan.
- 4. Upon Commission approval of this Stipulation, the OSC proceeding shall be closed.
