We are in the early stages of providing data to local governments for climate planning purposes. PG&E is willing to work with local governments to provide them with information that enables them to complete their climate planning efforts. In order to protect the confidentiality of customer data and proprietary business data, and consistent with the attached statewide energy usage data policy statement that the IOUs jointly developed, PG&E is requiring an NDA from each city before providing a map of their city's EUC marketing potential. When we spoke a few weeks ago, [Redacted] stated that he thought that giving maps (using zip/zip plus four approach and applying the 15/15 rule) to local government entities for CAP or EUC purposes would require them to sign a non-disclosure agreement.

Could you confirm? To me, this would seem odd, as the purpose of the 15/15 approach, as I understand the utilities application of it, is to ensure that no customer-specific information is released.
