Subject: Update on Operational Changes

PG&E Team:

Since announcing the changes within our operations management structure last week, many employees have asked about the new reporting structure. The first thing to note is that this transition will be a two-step process. Some changes will take place immediately, while others will happen after the senior vice presidents for gas and electric operations are both in their new roles. As my note last week mentioned, we expect that process to take several months. We've included a chart below with the interim reporting structure.

The rationale for this restructuring was straightforward: Creating two distinct lines of business will provide clear ownership and accountability for gas and electric operations, and it will enable the leaders throughout these business lines to sharpen their focus on their respective areas.

Additionally, having the senior vice president of each organization report directly to me will enable me to be closer to our operations on a day-to-day basis—a change that I felt strongly was the right thing for our company at this critical time.

In recent weeks, we have interviewed a number of strong candidates for the position of senior vice president of gas operations. We are now in the process of narrowing down the list. We hope to introduce to you our new leader of gas operations in the near future.

Thank you for working to make PG&E the safest, most reliable utility in the country and for putting the customer at the center of all we do.
