The communication occurred on Thursday, April 7, 2011, at approximately 12:30 p.m., at the offices of California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC). The communication was oral and the attached handout was provided. [Rule 8.3(a)(c)]

Jennifer Dowdell, Director-Regulatory Relations, PG&E, initiated the communication with Colette Kersten, Interim Energy Advisor to Commissioner Catherine Sandoval. Also present were: Kerry Klein, Attorney, and Roger Graham, Acting Director -Gas Operations, both for PG&E; and Joe Karp, Attorney with Winston & Strawn LLP, representing Calpine Corporation and California Cogeneration Council. Mr. Graham, Mr. Karp, and Ms. Klein explained the history of the Gas Accord Settlements and basic cost recovery mechanisms. Mr. Graham reiterated PG&E's arguments as to why the contested issues in the Gas Accord V settlement are appropriately denied in the proposed decision. [Rule 8.3(c)]
