

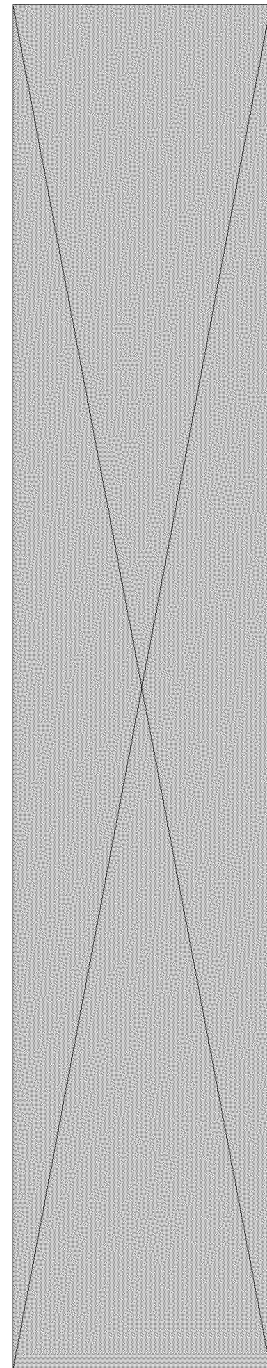
CPUC Considering Changes for 408 Area Code

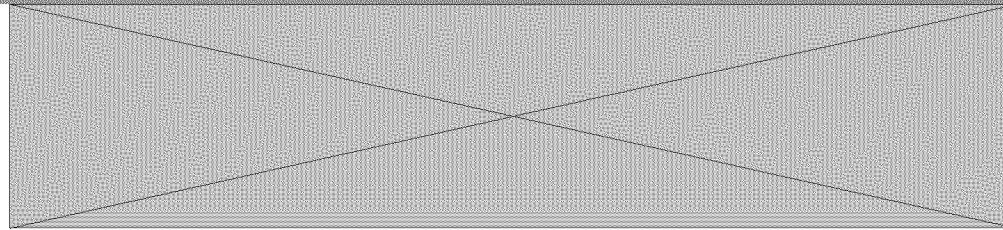
The CPUC in March held five Public Participation Meetings to obtain input from the public into whether the 408 area code
