* Item 45 (A.09-09-013) adopts the Gas Accord V Settlement Agreement for PG&E and requires PG&E to provide a semi-annual Gas Transmission and Storage Safety Report to allow CPUC staff to monitor PG&E's pipeline-related activities, to assess whether high risk projects are being built, and to track whether PG&E is spending its allocated funds on pipeline-related safety, reliability, and integrity activities.
