Hi All,

In regards to the issue of possible multiple triggers for one PIP Addendum, it may make sense instead of treating each upload as a separate addendum (like we're doing now), instead, create one addendum in the website and then allow for multiple trigger sheets to be uploaded for that addendum.

Some questions are:

1. Does this make sense? To create one addendum online and then enable multiple trigger sheets (the template) to be uploaded?
2. If we have multiple triggers per addendum, could the "Addendum Date" be used as the

unique identifier for the addendum? If not, we could auto-generate one, but the addendum date may be more intuitive and meaningful.

3. If we do this, does the template need to be revised in any way? For example, should any fields be pulled out from the trigger-level to the addendum-level?
