* Members of the **Independent Review Panel** the CPUC formed to examine PG&E's gas pipeline rupture in San Bruno will brief the CPUC's Commissioners on the Panel's report at 9:30 a.m. The report will be available online at www.cpuc.ca.gov/PUC/events/sanbruno.htm following the presentation.

* **Item 28** (R.11-02-019) directs gas transmission line operators to complete ongoing maximum allowable operating pressure calculations and to prepare a plan to pressure test or replace all natural gas pipelines not so tested. The proposal is available at <http://docs.cpuc.ca.gov/EFILE/PD/135030.pdf>.

* **Item 31** opens a fact-finding proceeding into the proposed acquisition by AT&T of T-Mobile. The proceeding will investigate, gather, and analyze information relevant to the proposed merger to determine whether the merger meets the requirements of applicable law and whether additional CPUC action is warranted. The proposal is not yet available.
