## Re: Extension of Time to Comply with Tariff Filing Requirement of Resolution L-411

I have received letters from the California Water Association and PacifiCorp requesting an extension of time to file advice letters incorporating into their tariffs the memorandum account established by Resolution L-411. These requests were timely submitted pursuant to Rule 16.6 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

The Ordering Paragraphs of Resolution L-411 are not entirely clear as to when utilities (other than PG&E) must file these tariff sheets. Furthermore, Resolution L-411-A on the Commission's June 23<sup>rd</sup> agenda, proposes to clarify various aspects of Resolution L-411 and to establish June 30<sup>th</sup> as the deadline for all of the Covered Utilities to file the required tariff sheets. Therefore, it is appropriate to grant an extension of time to comply with this tariff-filling provision, and to make it applicable to all of the utilities required to incorporate the memorandum account into their tariffs. Granting such an extension should not be problematic because the memorandum accounts are effective for all Covered Utilities as of the date of Resolution L-411.

Accordingly, there is hereby granted to all utilities for whom Resolution L-411 established a memorandum account an extension of time to file advice letters incorporating that memorandum account into their tariffs. This extension of time shall expire on the earlier of: (i) July 31, 2011 and (ii) the date required by Resolution L-411-A as that Resolution is approved by the Commission.

As this letter is being sent to all parties on the Service List for Resolution L-411, the parties who requested the extension are excused from the otherwise applicable requirement of Rule 16.6 to inform all parties of the extension.
