Per our phone conversation, just a heads-up in case you receive questions at the CPUC.

Attached is a copy of the letter PG&E left for residents of this neighborhood if they were not home for us to talk to them in person. PG&E personnel are canvassing this area in South San Francisco this morning and are trying to talk live to residents of each home.

This letter will only be left in the event that no one is at home when we visit. The purpose is to explain why PG&E will be working in the area longer than originally expected, to express our understanding that this work may be an inconvenience and our desire to minimize disruption to residents.

As you may recall, we completed a successful hydro test of L-132 segments from San Bruno station to Hillsdale station. Field personnel had been telling residents that we would be wrapping up in their neighborhood very soon. Unfortunately, due to our desire to investigate the girth welds and minor dent on these segments, PG&E crews will likely be in their neighborhood for longer than anticipated.
