I also wanted to bring the below issue to your attention. As President of the Women's

Network, I was alerted of a CPUC attorney investigating a conflict of interest regarding a scholarship we plan to award a dependent of an employee at the CPUC. Our scholarship application did not ask where the parents worked, so we did this unknowingly and will revoke it should the Legal Division or their outside counsel find it a conflict. See below for more description.

John,

I'm not sure who we should alert in Regulatory Relations, but Linda Filchev from the Legal Division at the CPUC has spoken to both myself and [Redacted] about a scholarship the PG&E Employees Community Fund (ECF) awarded to a dependent of an employee at the CPUC. The award was made by the Women's Network Employee Resource Group. I think they are trying to determine if there is a conflict of interest.

As background, the ECF is a 501(c)(3) organization that awards scholarships that are funded primarily from employee contributions from the Campaign for the Community. For 2011, the ECF is awarding \$256,500 in scholarships to 154 students in the PG&E service territory. Neither [Redact] or I know which award recipient is the dependent of the CPUC employee.

Should someone in Reg. Rel. be made aware of the issue?
