## NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATION OF PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY

Pursuant to Rule 8.4(a) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby gives notice of the following ex parte communication. The communication occurred on Friday, July 8, 2011 at approximately 3:30 p.m. by telephone to the California Public Utilities Commission. The communication was oral and involved no handout. Sidney Dietz, Director, Regulatory Relations, PG&E, initiated the communication with Matthew Tisdale, Advisor to Commissioner Michael Florio. [Rule 8.4(b)]

Mr. Dietz stated that the CPUC has the authority to allow the use of unspent funds to allow Energy Efficiency (EE) programs can continue as adopted in D.09-09-047. Mr. Dietz further stated that the use of these unused and uncommitted funds is a simple and elegant solution to the problem of the gas raid, and that it works for all three utilities.
