Sidney Dietz, Director, Regulatory Relations, PG&E, initiated the communication with Matthew Tisdale, Advisor to Commissioner Michael Florio. [Rule 8.4(b)]

Mr. Dietz stated that the CPUC has the authority to allow the use of unspent funds to allow Energy Efficiency (EE) programs can continue as adopted in D.09-09-047. Mr. Dietz further stated that the use of these unused and uncommitted funds is a simple and elegant solution to the problem of the gas raid, and that it works for all three utilities. Mr. Dietz stated that the ruling contemplates a solution that is complicated and insufficient to continue EE programs at their current pace. [Rule 8.4(c)]
