Dear valued San Bruno customer:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) is preparing to perform requested work on a section of Pipeline 132 that is no longer in service in the Glenview neighborhood. Crews will be on-site Thursday, July 28 and Friday, July 29 to examine and remove sections of pipe at the direction of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC). This work will be performed between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on both days; however construction may be delayed in the event of weather or other circumstances.

This work will require PG&E to dig at a number of excavation sites on Glenview Drive, including one site located just north of Claremont Drive and another site between Claremont Drive and Earl Avenue. Traffic may be affected while work is being performed and a flagger will be in place to assist motorists.

You may notice additional PG&E trucks and personnel near the work sites. Please be assured that we are doing everything possible to limit any inconvenience to you and your community. We understand this work may be disruptive and we thank you for your patience and cooperation as we work in your neighborhood.
