Pursuant to Rule 3.2(b) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, San Diego Gas & Electric Company (U 902-E) ("SDG&E") hereby gives notice of the *Application for Approval of ERRA Compliance for 2010 and Rate Recovery of ERRA-Related Accounts, filed June 1, 2011*. In compliance with California Public Utility Code Section 454.5, relevant Decisions ("D.") of the California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission" or "CPUC"), including but not limited to, D.02-10-062, D.02-12-074, D.03-06-067, and D.04-01-050, and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, San Diego Gas & Electric Company ("SDG&E") hereby submits its Application for approval of: (i) contract administration, least cost dispatch and power procurement activities in 2010, (ii) costs related to those activities recorded in the Energy Resource Recovery Account ("ERRA") and Transition Cost Balancing Account ("TCBA") in 2010 and (iii) costs recorded in related regulatory accounts in 2010, including the Market Redesign and Technology Upgrade Memorandum Account ("MRTUMA"), Renewables Portfolio Standard Memorandum Account ("RPSMA"), and Independent Evaluator Memorandum account ("IEMA"). If approved as proposed, a typical monthly summer electric bill (based on 500 kilowatt-hours of electricity) will increase from approximately \$80.99 to \$81.01 (or 0.02 percent) for inland customers and from approximately \$90.17 to \$90.22 (or 0.06 percent) for coastal customers. A typical monthly bill for residential customers who use 1,000 kilowatt-hours per month will increase from approximately \$232.31 to \$232.52 (or 0.09 percent) for inland customers and from approximately \$243.41 to \$243.65 (or 0.1 percent) for coastal customers. SDG&E's small commercial customers will see an increase of approximately \$0.24 on their monthly summer electric bill (or 0.08 percent), based on 1,500 kWh of electricity for secondary service.







 If the CPUC approves SDG&E's request for recovery of the costs accrued during 2010 in the MRTUMA, IEMA and RPSMA, a typical non-CARE residential customer living in the inland climate zone and using 500 kilowatt-hours per month could see a monthly summer bill increase of 0.02%, or \$0.02. A typical monthly electric bill could increase from \$80.99 to \$81.01. The percentages shown do not necessarily reflect the changes that you may see on your bill. Changes in individual bills will also depend on how much electricity each customer uses.
