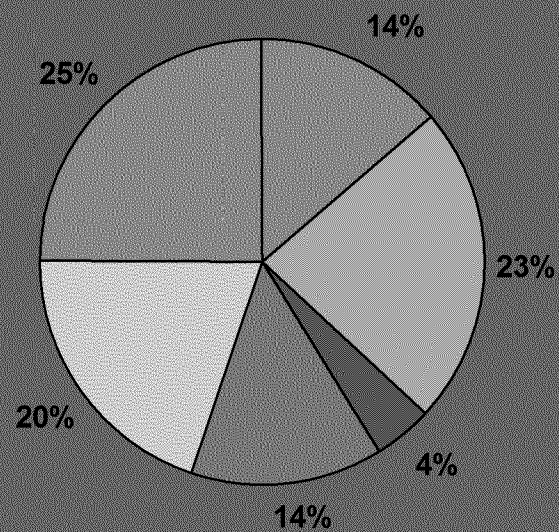
Investments by Minority Served

- In 2010, PG&E gave a total of \$19.3 million in charitable grants to nonprofit organizations

- 75 percent or \$14.5 million of the total went to minority-focused projects and initiatives (See appendix for details)

- This year, PG&E is on track to trend in line with last year's giving towards minority-focused projects and initiatives
