
Decision 09-09-047 directed the IOUs and Energy Division to collaboratively develop and refine Market Transformation Indicators (MTIs) for the 2010-2012 program cycle. Subsequent Commission direction in Resolution E-4385 established a deadline of September 2011 for posting these final MTIs, and Energy Division scheduled a workshop for early September 2011 to finalize the MTIs and agree on a reporting template.

Citing the nature of the collaborative process and the need to develop indicators that will persist over time and transcend program cycles, Energy Division has requested a 4-month extension in order to ensure that all parties are properly engaged in the process, participate in the workshops, and develop indicators that will be utilized in the long term.

In the interest of developing MTIs that will be sufficiently robust to aid in the achievement of the market transformation goals described in the California Long-Term Energy Efficiency Strategic Plan, the Commission grants Energy Division's request for a 4-month extension to complete MTI development by the end of January 2012.

Energy Division is instructed to communicate this approved schedule extension, by email, to all parties to A.08-07-021 and R.09-11-014.
