Redacted has opened Sierra's OEC to respond to a burning rail tanker filled with liquid propane.

Redacted will report to City of Lincoln's command center.

PG&E operates an above ground reg station located approximately 1000 feet away form the burning tanker.

Sierra T&R is mobilizing personnel to a different reg station that supplies the transmission pipeline (274 MAOP, 255 NOP) that feeds the above ground reg station.

The plan at this time is to have personnel standby at various valves. These valves can be operated to isolate the transmission line (255 psig) and above regulator station. If these valves are closed and pipeline blown down flat, we would lose 2 large customers and 4 residential customers. We have notified the Account Manager to notify these two large customers Redacted to prepare for a curtailment.
