Dear Judge DeAngelis-

The purpose of this email is to request a short (two week) extension of time to file PG&E's Tier 2 advice letter to modify its Electric Rates Tariff Schedule E-9(B) in compliance with Ordering Paragraph 2 of D.11-07-029, the recent Phase 2 Electric Vehicle policy decision issued by the CPUC on July 25. The ordering paragraph requires PG&E to file its revised tariffs within 60 days of the effective date of the decision, which was July 14, but the decision was not publicly issued until 11 days later, on July 25. PG&E is supportive of the tariff revision, but because of the delay in issuance of the decision and the vacation schedules of our rate design personnel, we are requesting a short extension of time to comply.

For these reasons, we respectfully request that the due date for filing our tariff changes under Ordering Paragraph 2 be extended from September 12 (60 days from effective date) to September 26 (two months and one day from issuance date).
