- 1) Telephone (Visa, MasterCard and Discover)
- 2) iPhone or Android applications- Mobile Bill Pay (Visa and MasterCard)
- 3) At a self-service bill payment kiosk at 17 of our customer service offices (Visa and MasterCard)

All credit card transactions on any of the channels above charge a \$1.45 fee that goes to the credit card processor (not PG&E).
