Subject: A.11-06-004 - Treatment of GHG costs and MEA load in PG&E revised testimony

To all parties in PG&E's 2012 ERRA Forecast proceeding, A.11-06-004:

This note is to inform parties, in advance of the 8/26/11 due date for intervenor testimony, that PG&E will file revised testimony on or before September 2, 2011 that will:

- Remove forecast 2012 GHG costs associated with cap and trade from PG&E's 2012 ERRA forecast. Should PG&E incur any costs as a result of cap and trade during 2012, PG&E will record those GHG costs in the ERRA balancing account for future disposition and recovery.
- Remove MEA Phase 2A load from PG&E's 2012 ERRA forecast (on August 9th, PG&E and MEA agreed that MEA's Phase 2B load should not be removed from PG&E's 2012 ERRA forecast).
