ANSWER 5

The electric system currently has surplus generation resources. Therefore, there is a high likelihood that resources will be available in 2011 for electric generation, even with the current changes to the natural gas system. For PG&E, surplus resources have been identified within PG&E's Resource Adequacy (RA) filings.
