Hello everyone -

I have received a variety of requests on the cost and payment options for state or governmental employees planning on attending the Bruce Foster retirement event at the St. Francis Yacht Club on August 17. We now have a better idea as to the cost per person. Because the cost of the event must include the rental of the room, food and accessories, we expect the total cost to be approximately \$116.00 per person (w/o refreshments) and about \$150.00 (with refreshments). Under the rules, we are prepared to be reimbursed directly by the state or local government participant or if

you choose, we are prepared to send a gift letter to your respective organizations that will cover the cost. If you choose to reimburse for the event directly, you can write your check to PG&E and we will divide the proceeds among the other utilities. If you choose to receive a gift letter, you will receive three letters for \$38, \$39, and \$39 from SDG&E, Edison and PG&E (since the three utilities are hosting the event jointly). My apologies for having to be so bureaucratic about this, but we don't want to violate any FPPC rules or place anyone in jeopardy of violating the FPPC rules.
