This Motion of Ormat Technologies Inc. ("Ormat Technologies") for Party Status ("Motion") is filed under Rules 1.4 and 11.1 of the California Public Utilities Commission's ("Commission") Rules of Practice and Procedure.

I. DESCRIPTION OF ORMAT TECHNOLOGIES

Ormat Technologies is a worldwide developer/owner of geothermal renewable energy facilities. Ormat Technologies currently operates 225 MW of renewable geothermal energy to serve California load. Ormat Technologies is developing new base load geothermal resources in or near California to support the fulfillment of California's aggressive Renewables Portfolio Standard ("RPS").

II. STATEMENT OF INTEREST

On July 12, 2011, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Anne E. Simon issued a ruling in R.11-05-005 requesting comments on implementation of new portfolio content categories for the RPS Program. By this Motion, Ormat Technologies seeks party status in order to file comments in response to ALJ Simon's request that are currently lodged with the Commission's Docket Office pending a ruling granting this Motion.
