Ms. Dowdell explained that the illustrative rate impact percentages for transportation customers described in Chapter 10 (table 10-3) of PG&E's testimony reflected only part of the cost of gas. Assuming costs equivalent to PG&E small commercial core procurement rates as shown in table 10-4 the average customer impact on the total cost of delivered gas is roughly 5%. [Rule 8.4(c)]
