All,

Wanted to make sure you are aware that there has been a major grid disturbance in Southern California. All 3,000 megawatts of power in SDG&E's territory is out. Blackout conditions exist in San Diego and upper portions of Mexico.

CAISO is getting ready to put out a news release. We understand there will be a transmission emergency through midnight tonight. There is no ETA for restoration as of yet.

Both units at SONGS tripped due to the power disturbance and that seems to have tripped every other unit in the system. The PG&E system is stable and both DCPD Units are stable.
