Gas scare over, Lowell High students back in class Jill Tucker, Chronicle Staff Writer

(10-03) 13:26 PDT SAN FRANCISCO -- Students at San Francisco's Lowell High

School are back in class after being evacuated this morning in response to a "light" gas smell at the campus, school district officials said.

All students were evacuated safely from the school at 1101 Eucalyptus Drive at about 11:15 a.m. as administrators called Pacific Gas and Electric Co.

District and PG&E officials conducted a safety check using "sophisticated leak-detection equipment," said PG&E spokesman Joe Molica.

No gas leak was found and the smell dissipated. Students returned to class at about 12:15 p.m. E-mail Jill Tucker at jtucker@sfchronicle.com.
