Key elements of the messaging and outreach are:

- This work should begin soon and last through December. When the work schedule is finalized, we will provide a follow-up to this message.
- After this earthquake safety work is completed this year, PG&E plans to further improve the safety of this pipeline in 2012 by replacing a two-mile section of the line.
