Subject: Update

As I understand it, there are two sets of documents. The first set was ordered under the OII and consists of thousands of documents and data responses and they are all public (except for redactions to employee names and specific pipeline locations). The media has these documents, provided by PG&E. The second set of documents consist of the ECTS database. This data base has hundreds of documents added to it daily and now consists of over 2 million documents. When we turned this over to the Commission, legal division agreed that it should be classified as 583 because it would be impossible to redact that many documents for names and locations. Despite that designation, if Bob had picked up the phone and asked us to release publicly the documents I received from Michelle, we would have done so willingly. We don't even know if the documents Michelle provided us as examples are even the documents Bob is claiming are safety related because he won't tell us what documents he is referring to. It will be extremely difficult to try and sort through over 2 million documents to find out his concern. That's the crux of the problem.
