CPUC Information Alert: CPUC Orders Temporary Halt to Transmission Line Stringing in Chino Hills

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) has sent the attached letter to Southern California Edison (SCE) regarding the utility's Tehachapi Renewable Transmission Project and possible violations of Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requirements.

For SCE to attain and maintain compliance with FAA regulations, the CPUC has directed the company to take a number of actions, including not performing any new or additional tower construction and conductor stringing in the areas that have a high probability of being subject to FAA mitigations. To that end, conductor stringing in the City of Chino Hills within 1,000 feet of any residence should not be undertaken.
