## Michelle and Paul

I have talked with Jane and Trina about our opportunity to use Burlingame as a test site where we would compile information about the location and condition of our gas infrastructure and present a work plan and communicate with the Burlingame city manager about it on a regular basis going forward.

We are pulling together people from gas engineering and elsewhere with a goal of reporting back and meeting with you next week.

It won't surprise you to hear that -- at least right now -- there is limited detailed information about the distribution system in particular. But developing a community infrastructure system mapping, assessment and work plan is consistent with our ongoing work on, among other things, TIMP and DIMP. So all this seems to fit together well in the long run. Jane expressed support for using this community infrastructure communication plan as a way to consolidate and more effectively respond to ongoing data requests.

Do you want to set aside a time next week for a potential get together? I don't expect Jane to be available, but of course others will be.
