Role of Bureau Veritas in PG&E Hydrostatic Test Program

In May 2011, PG&E engaged Bureau Veritas to provide two specific services in support of the PG&E Hydrostatic Test program.

- 1. Conduct a review of the PG&E process to validate the maximum allowable operating pressure (MAOP) through hydrostatic testing
 - a. Work consists of verifying that the hydrostatic test procedure meets all codes, policies, and procedures established to ensure safe operations of gas pipeline
- 2. For each hydrostatic test, verify that the test was completed in accordance with the site specific test procedure
 - a. Bureau Veritas is expected to witness each hydrostatic test and provide certification that each test met the requirements as specified in site specific test procedure
