

## Role of Bureau Veritas in PG&E Hydrostatic Test Program

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In May 2011, PG&E engaged Bureau Veritas to provide two specific services in support of the PG&E Hydrostatic Test program.

1. Conduct a review of the PG&E process to validate the maximum allowable operating pressure (MAOP) through hydrostatic testing
  - a. Work consists of verifying that the hydrostatic test procedure meets all codes, policies, and procedures established to ensure safe operations of gas pipeline
2. For each hydrostatic test, verify that the test was completed in accordance with the site specific test procedure
  - a. Bureau Veritas is expected to witness each hydrostatic test and provide certification that each test met the requirements as specified in site specific test procedure
