At approximately 2:30AM on 11/1/11, an explosion occurred at [Redacted] in Richmond. Gas was stopped at 2:40AM by the fire department. When gas was shut off at the meter, there was no smell or indication of gas released. The cause of the explosion is currently unknown and is under investigation.

The explosion caused 2 injuries and \$50K+ of damage to the property. Major Bay Area media is also on site.

This incident was reported to the CPUC at 5:50AM.
