Want you to be aware of pipeline repair work that PG&E will begin Monday Nov 7 in the area south of Los Vaqueros Reservoir. We have been conducting in-line testing on L-131 south of the Los Vac Reservoir to Fremont. The inspection identified weaknesses that merited immediate pressure reduction and the reduced pressure on L-131 has affected flow capacity on the Bay Area Loop. Now we need to begin repairs immediately to avoid any loss of service to about 3000 customers in the Tri-Valley area (Dublin, San Ramon, Livermore), especially in light of colder winter weather and increasing demand.

The repair sites are located predominantly in grazed, open non-native grasslands. CNDDDB records show potential upland habitat within three miles for the CA Tiger Salamander and the CA Red-leg Frog. Crews will do everything they can to avoid and minimize any impact and will have qualified biological monitors at each construction site. Work should be done by the end of November."
