Gary contacted me that PG&E has again been lagging on the discovery responses. He emailed Bruce, of PG&E, yesterday but have not yet heard back. Unfortunately, it is delaying the completion of the report.

To date, PG&E has only answered 24 of the 59 questions in the ninth data request--dated Oct. 6th.
