Subject: Heads up about the end to daily High/Low Inventory OFOs for backbone customers

Michelle

Last July PG&E instituted a system of notifying the large backbone gas customers about daily High/Low Operational Flow Orders (OFOs) to deal with fluctuations in supply and demand.

We are now at a stage following hydrostatic testing and other pipeline capacity-related actions where we anticipate having increased available total system inventory in place by December 1. This increased inventory will eliminate the necessity of calling daily high/low inventory OFOs as we had been doing in recent months. (We may still need to call one-sided OFOs as needed in the future.) But generally this signals a positive return to more stable daily operations.

Here's a link to an internal article about this issue. It's my understanding that you (or CPSD) were notified last July when this began, so we just wanted you to be aware that it is about to stop.
