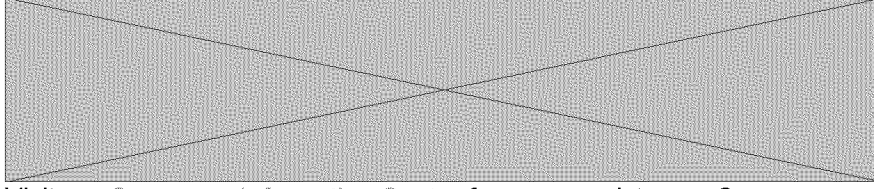
The CPUC has opened a penalty consideration case into whether PG&E violated CPUC or federal rules regarding pipeline classification.

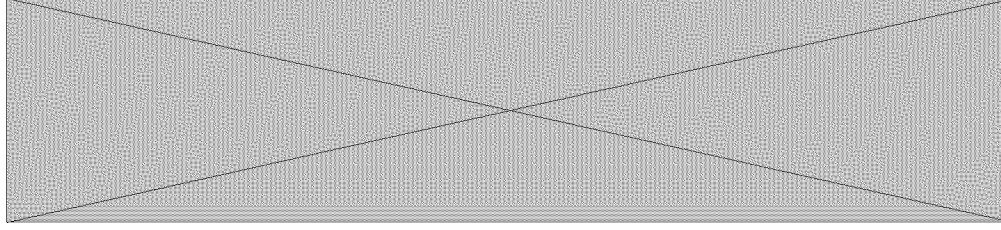

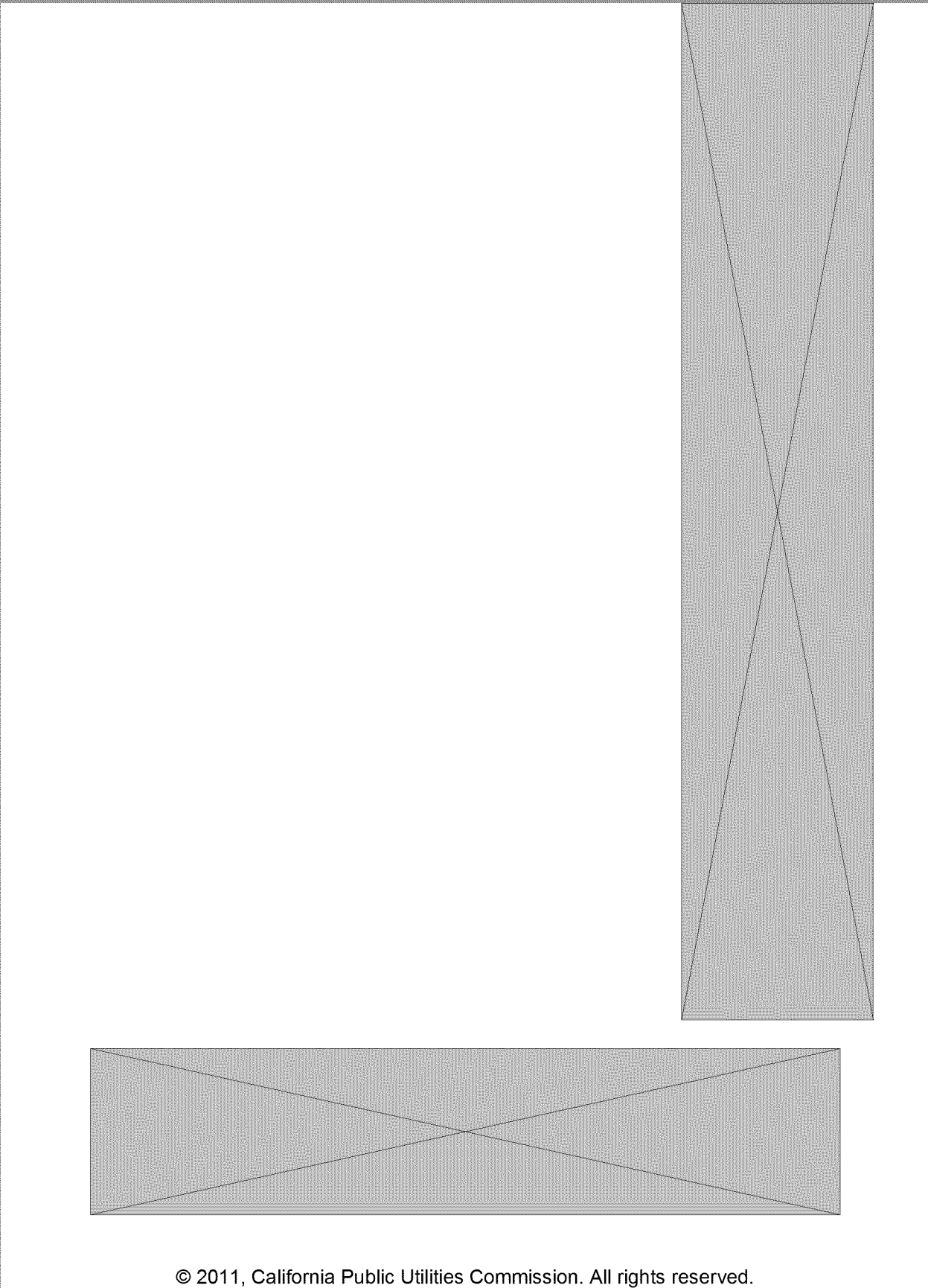
