A lot has happened with the RPS program, primarily within PG&E's portfolio over the last several months since Meredith has been out so I think it would be good to debrief before you are busy with your new assignment. Specifically, the NorthStar and Abengoa contracts have raised significant issues about how RPS procurement is being managed by PG&E and administered by Energy Division staff.
