Thank you for your letter of November 15, 2011, following up on the status of PG&E's commitment to supplement our response to CPUC 156, question 11, once we are able to develop the necessary information.

As we discussed at great length during our November 8, 2011 meeting, PG&E, working with Willbros, is doing a thorough, segment by segment review of the circumstances surrounding the potential class changes and the potential out of class situations, including the reasons for the class change and when it occurred. During our meeting, we reviewed our progress in that regard, and the considerable work that remains. We remain determined to provide this information to you by the end of the year, as previously indicated.

In response to CPUC 164, Question 11, PG&E provided the names and contact information for over 100 current and former employees in mapping, pipeline engineering, estimating, operating supervisors, and GSM&TS Maintenance Superintendents. A copy of that list is enclosed (and is again being submitted under Public Utilities Code section 583). Although PG&E may determine that other employees are more knowledgeable about the specific circumstances of a particular class change once our ongoing efforts described above are complete, the attached list is probably the best list of potentially knowledgeable employees.
