Subject: Update to Pacific Gas and Electric Company's Conformed 2006 Long-Term Procurement Plan - Brokerages and Exchanges Listing

Purpose

Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") hereby requests approval from the California Public Utilities Commission ("CPUC" or "Commission") to update its Conformed 2006 Long-Term Procurement Plan's ("LTPP") list of brokerages and exchanges to add four brokerages: Spectron Energy Inc., Karbone Inc., BGC Environmental Brokerage Services, L.P., and Edge Energy, LLC. In addition, PG&E proposes adding one exchange: Green Exchange, LLC (GreenX) and one futures commission merchant: BNP Paribas Prime Brokerage Inc.

Background

In accordance with Decision ("D.") 07-12-052, all updates proposed to the Conformed 2006 LTPP are made via advice letter. Advice letter updates are to include red-lined pages of the Conformed 2006 LTPP, as well as clean replacement pages.¹ Below, PG&E describes the updates to its Conformed 2006 LTPP and Attachments A and B reflect the relevant changes to PG&E's Conformed 2006 LTPP. Attachment A is the red-lined version of the changes and Attachment B is the clean version of the changes.²

² PG&E's 2010 Bundled Procurement Plan ("BPP") filed in Rulemaking ("R.") 10-05-006 is currently pending before the Commission for approval. To the extent the BPP is approved before this advice letter is approved, PG&E will update the BPP list of brokerages and exchanges to reflect the brokerages and exchanges addressed in this advice letter.

Additional Brokerages and Exchanges Listing

In an effort to allow additional options for executing physical greenhouse gas (“GHG”) product trades, PG&E requests to add the following to its list of authorized brokerages and exchanges (Appendix H of its Conformed 2006 LTPP):

- Karbone Inc.
- BGC Environmental Brokerage Services, L.P.
- Edge Energy, LLC

Exchanges and Futures Commission Merchants:

- Green Exchange, LLC (GreenX)
- BNP Paribas Prime Brokerage Inc.

Authorizing these additions to PG&E’s list of approved brokerages and exchanges does not obligate PG&E to use them. Instead, adding these brokerages and exchanges will simply provide PG&E an option to do so. The decision to use these or any enabled brokerages or exchanges and futures commission merchants in Appendix H will be made on a transaction-by-transaction basis consistent with the authority provided under PG&E’s Commission-approved Conformed 2006 LTPP. PG&E has routinely updated its list of brokerages and exchanges in order to add potential new counterparties for transactions that are consistent with PG&E’s Conformed 2006 LTPP.
