

## OPENING COMMENTS OF THE UTILITY REFORM NETWORK AND THE COALITION OF CALIFORNIA UTILITY EMPLOYEES ON THE PROPOSED DECISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE SIMON SETTING PROCUREMENT QUANTITY REQUIREMENTS FOR RETAIL SELLERS FOR THE RENEWABLES PORTFOLIO STANDARD PROGRAM

Pursuant to Rule 14.3 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, The Utility Reform Network (TURN) and the Coalition of California Utility Employees (CUE) submit these opening comments on the Proposed Decision (PD) of ALJ Simon on the renewable procurement targets required by the new §399.15(b) contained in SBx2 (Simitian).

TURN/CUE urge the Commission to adopt the PD without modification at the next possible opportunity. The proposed interpretation of §399.15(b) is fully consistent with the text of the statute, the intent of Legislature and the expectations of the stakeholders working closely on the development of SBx2. The linear trend approach to targets in the 2014-2016 and 2017-2020 compliance periods is also entirely feasible. The Commission is well aware that the most recent solicitation for renewable generation produced an enormous number of offers and vastly more generation than needed to obtain these quantities. It will not be challenging for the utilities to enter into sufficient power purchase agreements to meet the procurement quantities represented by a linear trend. Finally, the PD ensures that all retail sellers will be obligated to procure sufficient quantities of renewable energy to ensure sustained growth in California's renewable energy markets.

The Commission should move expeditiously to resolve the other issues related to banking, grandfathering, deficits, legacy flexible compliance rules and penalties. Until the Commission adopts clear rules on these compliance elements, retail sellers will face significant uncertainty regarding their overall RPS obligations and developing optimal procurement strategies.
