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Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph (OP) 4 of Decision (D.)11-09-006 and OPs 3-5 of D.11-10-010, on October 31, 2011, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) submitted Supporting Information for lifting operating pressure restrictions on Lines 101, 132A, and 147. PG&E hereby submits a correction to Exhibit B – Line 101 Shorts, Volume 2 of 3, Pages B-1103 and B-1106.

PG&E's Supporting Information, consisting of twelve volumes of exhibits, contained certain detailed maps drawings and tables with sensitive information concerning the location of critical infrastructure, the disclosure of which could pose a public safety risk. Consequently, PG&E filed and served on the parties a redacted copy of these sensitive exhibits. At the same time, PG&E provided the Commission's Consumer Protection and Safety Division a confidential copy of the same exhibits pursuant to Public Utilities Code section 583.

In the course of reviewing the exhibits, PG&E discovered an error in one data line of the Maximum Allowable Operating Pressure (MAOP) Report regarding a tap line connected to Line 101 designated GCUST 5783. This MAOP Report appears in Exhibit B – Line 101 Shorts,
