NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATION

Pursuant to Rule 8.4 of the California Public Utilities Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Cogeneration Association of California (CAC) and the California Cogeneration Council (CCC) respectfully submit the following ex parte communication.

On December 7, 2011, Michael Alcantar, Executive Director and counsel to CAC, and Beth Vaughn, Executive Director of CCC, met first with Damon Franz and Carol Brown, advisors to President Peevey, from approximately 3:00 to 3:30 pm, and second with Michael Colvin, advisor to Commissioner Ferron, from approximately 3:30 to 4:00 pm. CAC and CCC initiated these meetings and both were held at the Commission offices in San Francisco. No handouts were provided at the meetings.

In both meetings CAC and CCC representatives presented concerns over the retention of obligations in the Long Term Procurement Proceeding to procure Combined Heat and Power resources consistent with the pending proposed decision from ALJ Allen.
